g) To organize residential/ day care school for the children with learning disabilities, dyslexia, Austim, attention deficit syndrome ADHD and mental retardation with associate conditions.

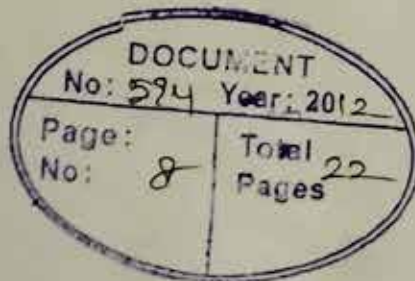

- h) To promote employment to women, rehabilitation enter partnership among women, educational training and financial assistance.



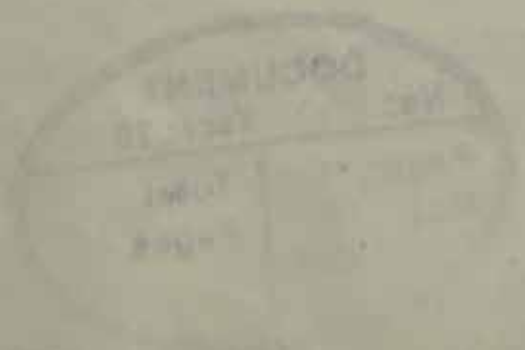

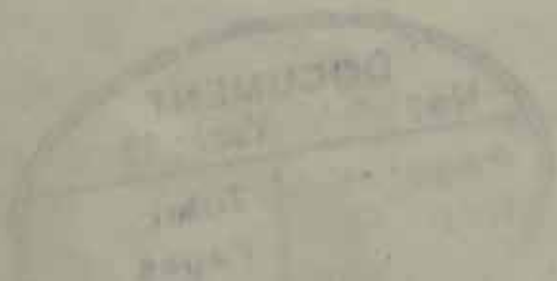

7. To appoint, persons, representatives agents on other works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the Trust.

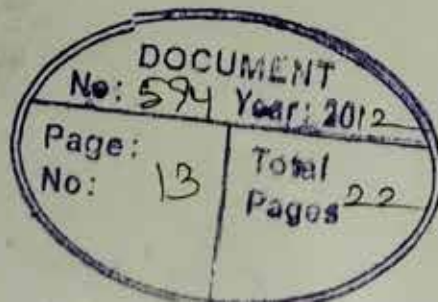

6.2 POWERS OF THE SECRETARY

- 1) He/She will :
 - i) Manage all the affairs of the trust.
 - ii) Convene Trust Board Meeting.
 - iii) Incur expenses accounting to the budget and produce receipts and account thereof in each trust Board meeting.
 - iv) Enter into all correspondence with all parties.
 - v) He shall authorities all payments to the treasure and the inform shall any after taking acquirement.
- 2) He is empowered to be present before authorise to give written petition, to correspond to maintain registration, flies etc., of the Trust to regularise the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.
- 3) He is also empowered to convene Trust Board meeting, to set up office to appoint clerks maintain registeres, flies etc., of the Trust to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.

6.3 POWER OF THE TREASURER

He will be in charge of the account and receipts for the amount in his custody, get the authorization of the Secretary for the disbursements or money, maintain the accounts, submit the money accounts to the Secretary, and arrange for the audit of the accounts. The Trust's Treasurer can keep the money of the Trust with up to limit Rs.5,000/- in order to meet to incidental expenses to be incurred for the purpose of security. Beyond the limit of Rs.5,000/- for incurring expenditure the Treasurer has to obtain the prior approval of the founders for such expenditure.

7. POWER OF THE FOUNDERS :

The Founders herein shall hold office at his pleasure and on the vacation of office by any one or more of the founder herein on their own violation or by death or otherwise the remaining founders herein shall appoint the legal heirs of the deceased founder. The Founders & Trustees shall pass any resolution by circulation in case of an urgent issue. They may make rules for regulation their meetings and the trustees may repeal later any rules made pursuant to this clause.

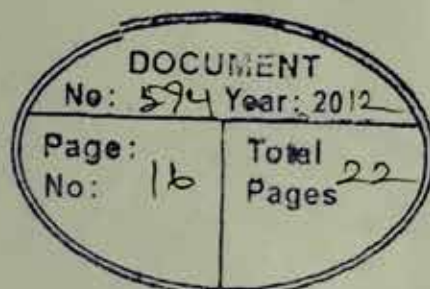

1. 2. In the event of closure of winding up dissolution of the trust all its assets and liabilities, if any shall be transferred to another trust which has similar object and enjoying Exemption U/s. 11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

4. The Income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilised towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of its income shall be utilised for payment to trustees by way of remuneration, profit, interest, dividends, etc., in sec. 13 (i) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

5. Not more than 5% of the income of the trust would be applied for any religious purpose or given to religious institutions.

6. Alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior of approval of Director of Income-Tax (Exemption) Chennai.

7. Any amendment to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of the Director of Income-Tax (Exemptions) Chennai.

8. The funds of the Trust would not be applied for any religious purposes of given to religious institutions.

9. The activities would be of purely charitable nature, not motivated for profit.

10. Any amendment to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).

11. Acquisition/alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions).

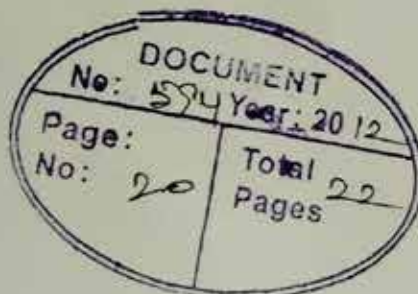

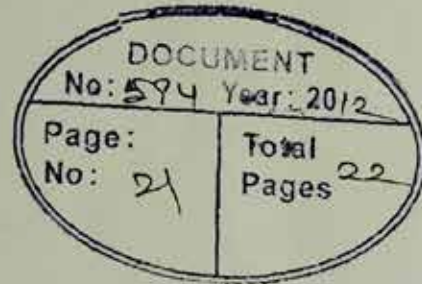
